

Budget and Finance	Here is the budget report for the first quarter of 2025. This includes income and expenses for the months of January, February, and March. Total income for the quarter was \$8,546. Group/Individual donations were \$4,252. This is about \$3200 less than the average quarterly income projection of \$7500. Other income includes interest and literature and those amounts are on course to meet projected income. Total expenses were \$13,428. We had projected spending \$2000 total on electricity, air conditioning, and natural gas. This quarter we spent over \$1000 on these utilities. The cost of heating the space was over \$400 in January and February. I'm concerned about what the cost of AC will be this summer and if there will be price hikes due to economic changes. We should consider increasing this budget to at least \$3000 and I would recommend adjustments to events and committee budgets to make up the difference. If this is approved then I would work with events and committee members on this. Judy has graciously offered some funds from workshops budget. Thank you for allowing me to be of service.
