Thank you for your service to Cape Atlantic Intergroup! I sent out 4 thank you letters for donations we received since we met last month. That's all I have! Thank you for letting me serve.
Treasurer	My apologies. I don't have a copy of the report to hand out because I printed the wrong report at work and was unable to print it out here in the office. A detailed Treasurer Report was attached to the email that was sent out with these minutes. If anyone wants a hard copy at the July business meeting please request it. I was only put on the bank accounts this week and obtained online privileges this afternoon. I don't have all the details on who donated and other income and expenses, but will have that updated for the next meeting. Our total income for the month of May going into June was \$2,338.08 and total expenses were \$3712.45. Total literature costs are \$1,023.00 and office overhead \$1,965.32. Our primary bank account has \$32,499.57. Literature balance is \$1,570.56 and the prudent reserve is \$31,769.88. The total amount over our prudent reserve is \$31,944.88. This is down almost \$3000 from last month so we are going through the extra funds rapidly. We have room to continue to decrease these funds, but if donations don't increase we will run through this money more rapidly than initially anticipated.
